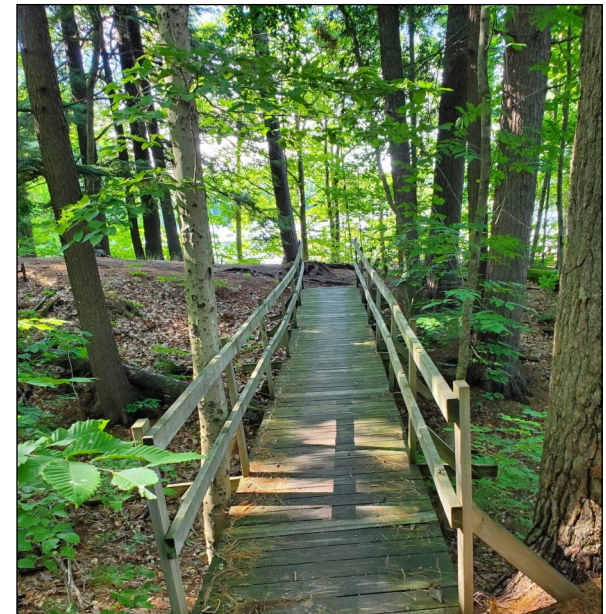

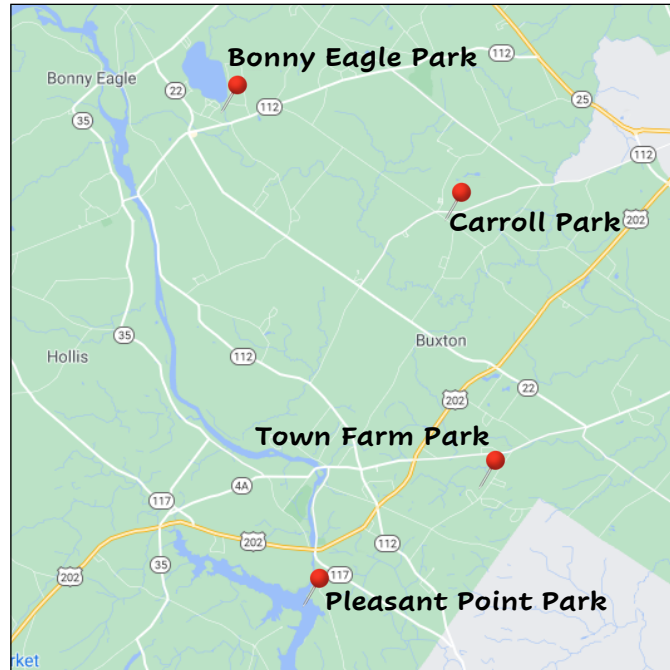
Park Directions
